Session Information

Oct. 10, 2017 — Understanding the Personality of Yourself and Others, session one

Have you ever had to work with someone who had a different personality style than you? In this session, participants will learn about different personality styles (including their own) and how to most effectively work with them in team and individual settings.

Oct. 24, 2017 — Citizenship: The Power of Individuals Working Together, session two

So much of what happens in our community gets decided on the local level. What are key ways for citizens to effectively work with their leaders? In this session participants will hear from a panel of locally-elected leaders, as well as a presenter on effective citizenship and community engagement.

Nov. 7, 2017 — Getting Things Done: Tips & Tricks, session three

There are only so many hours in a day, how does one not burn out? In this session participants will hear from a panel of local community members engaged in community-oriented activities. The frame work of the Seven Habits of Highly-Effective People will be introduced.

Nov. 21, 2017 — Communication in Today's World, session four

Is there a difference in communication styles between the "Greatest Generation" and "Generation Y"? Many people think so. This session will cover generational differences in how people communicate and interact with each other. Further, participants will learn about effective messaging and communication strategies.

Dec. 5, 2017 — Leading in a Changing World, session five

Participants will learn how individuals can positively affect their community and state. Participants will hear how different community events and community functions got started. Volunteer opportunities will be presented, and participants will discuss their work on issues and projects.
